

340B IMPACT PROFILE

The federal 340B Program allows us to provide affordable medication to our patients, and it helps us generate 340B savings that we use to improve patient care and expand access to services. Howard Brown Health is a federally qualified health clinic established in 1974. We served 35,000+ patients in 2022 at 10 clinics across Chicago.

MEDICATION ACCESS

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Prescription voucher program: Provided 9328 prescription vouchers for uninsured patients, totaling \$225,594 in savings for our patients



Chronic disease management: Vouchers for medications and supplies ensure that our low-income patients can manage their chronic conditions like diabetes and asthma



Contract pharmacies: HBH has over 177 contract pharmacy relationships to ensure patients have a convenient location to access their medication

EXPANDED SERVICES

340B savings help to fund and maintain a wide variety of critical services that we offer to the community. Many of these programs are unique to HBH and would not be able to operate without 340B savings.

- The Broadway Youth Center provides a comprehensive suite of primary care, behavioral health, and social service programs for unhoused LGBTQ+ youth.
- Our transgender and non-binary health teams provide affirming and lifesaving services including hormone therapy, group therapy, and gender-affirming surgical navigation.
- The HIV case management team links patients to important support services including insurance navigation, affordable housing, and transportation assistance for people living with HIV.
- The 63rd St. dental clinic provides free and subsidized full service dental care, including oral exams and oral cancer screenings. The dental clinic was able to see 2,109 patients in 2022.
